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1. Second Conditional (hipótesis presentes)

Estructura: If + past simple, would + infinitive

Ejercicios

- 1) If I ___ (be) you, I would apologize.
- 2) She would travel more if she ___ (have) time.
- 3) If we ___ (win) the lottery, we would buy a house.
- 4) What would you do if you ___ (lose) your phone?
- 5) Correct: If I would have more money, I would study abroad.
- 6) Complete: If he were more confident, ___.
- 7) Transform: She is shy, so she does not speak in class.
- 8) Transform: I do not know her number, so I cannot call her.

2. Third Conditional (hipótesis pasadas)

Estructura: If + past perfect, would have + past participle

Ejercicios

- 1) If they ___ (leave) earlier, they would have caught the train.
- 2) She would have passed if she ___ (study) more.
- 3) If I had seen you, I ___ (say) hello.
- 4) If we had known, we ___ (not come).
- 5) Transform: He missed the alarm. He arrived late.
- 6) Transform: I did not save money, so I did not buy the laptop.
- 7) Correct: If you would have told me, I would have helped.
- 8) Write one third conditional sentence about a past regret.
